Full of racy mouth-watering mineral flavours with melons, peaches and pears and a clean fresh finish.
- 167 **Pouilly Fume, Serge Dagueneau, Loire, France** 2015 **29.00**
Loaded with vibrant gooseberry and grapefruit flavours with suggestions of gunflint and fresh cut flowers.
- 168 **Sancerre, Michel Girard, Loire, France** 2015 **29.00**
Well-made wine with fore flavours of Mediterranean fruit and subtle complexity and acidity, topped off with delicious green notes. Offerings from a master wine maker.
- 169 **Pinot Grigio, Castel Firmain, Mazzacorona, Veneto, Italy** 2015 **25.00**
From the heartland of Veneto, a brilliant example of Pinot Grigio done the way it should, subtle but present and never underwhelming.

Red Wines

Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely with notes of black pepper and dried fruits. A juicy and silky mouthful that persists on the fruity finish.
- 176 **Château La Grande Maye, Bordeaux, France** 2012 **22.00**
Clean fruit, pretty nose, purple hints on the palate, plenty of ripeness and racy, country tannins, fantastic value.
- 178 **Crozes Hermitage Rouge, Etienne Pochon, Rhône, France** 2014 **23.00**
Seductive, soft creamy bramble and blueberry fruit, touches of spice and as alluring and approachable as ever with a great depth and density.
- 179 **Fleurie, Château de Raousset, Beaujolais, France** 2015 **28.00**
Seductive, full flavoured and structured fine wine with hints of wild strawberries and slightly gamey notes.
- 180 **Marsannay Les Longeroies, Burgundy, France** 2013 **49.00**
A sophisticated Marsannay with a full ripe, dark and vibrant fruit profile and underlying aromas of the forest floor, with a gentle and refreshing finish.
- 181 **Châteauneuf du Pape, Mont-Redon, Rhône, France** 2012 **37.00**
This is a boisterous and hearty Châteauneuf, but certainly not a heavy wine, in fact it's very juicy and young, exhibiting lovely damson, red berry and plum stone character with hints of spice, sap and undergrowth.

Burgundy

- 20 **Macon Uchizy, Gérald et Philibert Talmard.** 2015 34.00
Pure and refreshing, achieved by early picking of ripe grapes whilst they still have good levels of acidity in them.
- 26 **Domaine Laroche Chablis St. Martin.** 2013 48.00
Bright yellow in colour with green hues. On the nose this wine displays intense aromas of citrus fruit, white peach and a marked mineral character which translate beautifully on the palate.
- 27 **St Veran, Domaine des Vieilles Pierres.** 2014 44.00
Full of crisp, boisterous, apple and citrus flavours with strong exotic fruit overtones set in a rounded and delicately buttered texture.
- 30 **Macon Verze, Domaine Leflaive.** 2015 72.00
Rich green-gold in colour, with a lovely perfume of floral white fruits and a hint of butter
- 31 **Rully Blanc Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Girardin.** 2014 72.00
Lively wine with ripe white fruits, well-balanced acidity and good weight on the mid-palate.
- 33 **Chablis, Montmains, 1er Cru, Laurent Tribut.** 2014 78.00
Notes of dry stones, minerals, rock salt, limestone, gently floral, racy lemon rind fruit character, wonderful.
- 32 **Pouilly Fuissé, Clos Reissier.** 2014 79.00
A significant aroma of white flowers, citrus fruits with a hint of almonds. An enjoyable drink all round.
- 35 **Puligny-Montrachet, Etienne Sauzet.** 2014 121.00
Notes of white flower and grape fruit on the nose followed by a palate full to bursting with butter, Mirabelle, citrus, mineral and chalk notes, whilst chowing plenty of fat the wine still maintains a fine precise character too.
- 34 **Meursault 1er cru, Olivier Laflaive.** 2011 151.00
Ample and full, rather like the 2006, but with a firm enough acidic edge to give this great balance and vivacity notes of butter, nut, honey, lemons, guava and limes.
- 36 **Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, Abbaye de Morgeot, O.Leflaive.** 2012 185.00
Delicious flavours of ripe and honeyed fruit, caramel, cream and butter on the finish.

Loire Valley

- 29 **Sauvignon de Touraine,** 2015 29.00
Gooseberry aromas, green fruit flavours with a crisp dry finish
- 38 **Muscadet-Sèvre-et-Maine sur lie, Domaine des Dorices,** 2015 36.00
A zesty nose full of white fruit flavours including apples, apricots finishing off with hints of minerality. The aromas develop on the palate with good acidity and balance before a crisp finish.
- 40 **Sancerre Alain Girard** 2015 44.00
A grand offering from a renowned estate, with distinct flavours of citrus fruits, hay and nettle and a competent balance between flavor and acidity.
- 28 **Pouilly Fume, Serge Dagueneau, Loire, France** 2015 53.00
Loaded with vibrant gooseberry and grapefruit flavours with suggestions of gunflint and fresh cut flowers.

Regional France

- 17 **Picpoul de Pinet L'Ormarie** 2015 28.00
Slightly perfumed, ripe melon fruit on the nose. The palate is weighty and ripe but remains fresh and saline. This is the perfect example of the right grapes grown in the right terroir.
- 37 **'Le Gavroche' Michel Roux & Michel Chapoutier, Roussillon** 2014 38.00
Deep greenish yellow in colour, a blending of roundness and freshness on the palate characteristic to the Viognier grape variety on these volcanic soils, subtle notes of pear and apricot.
- 24 **Côtes du Rhône Belleruche Blanc, Chapoutier, Rhône** 2014 43.00
A subtle combination of Bourboulenc and white Grenache, this is intense and fresh on the nose with ripe fruits and floral hints on the palate, leading to a clean, crisp and lingering finish.
- 43 **Domaine Gavoty Cuvée Clarendon White Côtes de Provence** 2011 48.00
Pale straw coloured with green tints, the nose shows fresh citrus fruits (grapefruit and lime) and hints of beeswax and toast. The palate is quite full and bone dry, possessed of a taut mineral structure and abundant crystalline fruit. It finishes with crisp acidity and great length.
- 49 **Le Soula, Vin de Pays des Côtes Catalanes, Blanc** 2011 68.00
A blend of Macabeu, Sauvignon blanc, Grenache blanc & Chardonnay. This is a wine with lots of depth. It offers a juicy, lively and slightly exotic style to go with ample citrus blossom, Medium-bodied, clean, with good acidity and a dry finish. A complex wine of great appeal.

Alsace

- 22 **Pinot Blanc, Albert Roux Label, Alsace** 2013 34.00
Hint of spice, well-rounded yet delicate, combines freshness and softness
- 21 **Riesling Turckheim Reserve, Alsace** 2015 38.00
Powerful citrus and floral fruit characters balanced with great minerality and a long crisp finish
- 39 **Gewürztraminer, Domaine Mure Alsace** 2014 52.00
Quite rich with a wonderful bouquet of poached pears. In the mouth it has a racing citrusy fullness with a good balance between richness and acidity. On the finish gentle spice flavours come through, followed by elegant floral notes that linger long after the bottle is finished.

- 42 Gruner Veltliner Sepp Moser, Austria** **2015** **35.00**
A combination citrus fruit characters such as lime and grapefruit with a hint of spice and a backbone of steely acidity. Dry and crisp.

Germany

- 41 Riesling, Kabinett, JJ Prum, Mosel, Germany** **2015** **49.00**
A wonderful blend of wine from JJ Prum's Bernkastel and Wehlen vineyards. Crisp, bright and clear, well defined, pure fruit flavours citrus, Breaburn apple, herbs, lime and touches of nectarine.

Italy

- 45 Gotto d'Oro Frascati Superiore** **2015** **34.00**
A Roman blend of Trebbiano, Malvasia and Greco done in a time honoured style by one of the first communes in the region of Lazio.
- 48 Olim Bauda, Gavi di Gavi DOCG.** **2016** **39.00**
Straw yellow colour with good intensity and attractive green reflections. The nose is intense with floral notes and ripe citrus. The taste is soft, lively and persistent.
- 44 Mazzacorona Pinot Grigio, Riserva.** **2014** **39.00**
Good fruit concentration on the palate with clean ripe fruit flavours
- 46 Gini, Soave, Classico.** **2015** **42.00**
Fragrant pineapple and apple blossom nose, a crisp, bursting, crystallised citrus fruit palate, racy notes of lemon rind and softer peach touches, long, ripe and intense, balanced by remarkably fresh acidity

Spain

- 66 Albarino Eidosela** **2015** **35.00**
Straw yellow with green flashes; it is clean and bright. It has a high intensity at nose; it is very fragrant, fruity and floral, fresh and subtle, recalling the peach and apricot. In the mouth is powerful, full-bodied and balanced acidity. Harmonious with many pleasant nuances.

Portugal

- 65 Bacalhoa Caterina, Setubal Peninsula** **2014** **39.00**
Traditional white wine made in the heritage and style of the area using indigenous grape varieties and oak.

USA

- 51 **Château Ste Michelle, Pinot Gris** 2013 44.00
Fresh aromas of melon, apple and a hint of spice, with a drop of Viognier adding texture and an attractive floral character to the palate

Australian

- 57 **Mountadam Chardonnay, Barossa** 2015 33.00
This un-oaked Chardonnay is fresh, uplifting, clean and full of peachy aromas. The palate is soft with hints of honey, melon and pears with a refreshing and crisp finish
- 55 **Jim Barry 'The Lodge Hill' Dry Riesling, Clare Valley** 2013 50.00
Subtle hints of lime with floral connotations and a toasty finish. The wine itself has won numerous accolades and is highly appraised by several critics.
- 56 **Voyager Estate, Sauvignon Blanc Sémillon, Margaret River** 2014 56.00
Subtle hints of fruit and delicate flowers.
- 59 **Pinot Gris, Lane Vineyard, Adelaide Hills** 2013 47.00
Peaches and cream on the nose. The palate is pure and mineral. Beautiful balance

New Zealand

- 62 **Hidden Bay, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** 2015 32.00
This Sauvignon Blanc has delicious flavours of gooseberry, well balanced zesty fruit, green apple and ripe melon, mixed with subtle herbaceous mineral notes. Rich in both flavour and complexity, this wine has all the hallmarks of wines from the Marlborough region of New Zealand.
- 64 **Chardonnay, Palliser Estate, Martinborough** 2014 41.00
The white flower flavours and aromas of peach and apricot are complimented by a subtle creamy vanilla palate from a judicious use of oak.

Chilean

- 67 **Andes Peak Sauvignon Blanc** 2014 28.00
Deliciously crisp and textural - leafy, lively and pure! Crisp and zesty with citrus fruit aromas, the ripe fruit palate is balanced with mineral notes and a zingy finish.

A blend of Chenin Blanc, Viognier & Chardonnay makes a wine with steely minerality and crisp Apple flavours
- 69 **Sauvignon Blanc, Springfield, Western Cape** 2015 41.00
This single vineyard originates from the rockiest soil on the estate, with resultant struggling vines and huge concentration. Delicious flavours of peppers and passionfruit.
- 61 **Bouchard Finlayson, Missionvale Chardonnay** 2013 68.00
Elaborate flavours of under-exposed wood tones with over-layers of pure vanilla, pear, mango and yeasty lees. A seamless wine, with much evolution and excitement on the mid palate. Added complexity and nutty flavours will enhance with a deeper and richer colour.

- 71 **Kahurangi Estate Nelson Rose, New Zealand** 2015 36.00
Made entirely from single vineyard Pinot Noir Grapes, this vibrant wine displays strawberry flavours and a well-rounded medium dry finish
- 70 **Cabezac Rose, France** 2013 39.00
The pale robe is the colour of pink rose petals the nose is a medley of red fruit aromas, strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant. The palate is fresh, crisp, fruity and ample
- 90 **Domaine Gavoty Cuvée Clarendon Rose, Côtes de Provence, France** 2015 43.00
Deceptively pale, the nose is full of crushed summer fruits, whilst the palate is a mouth-watering blend of strawberries and redcurrants, allied to a creamy texture, considerable weight and a long crisp finish.

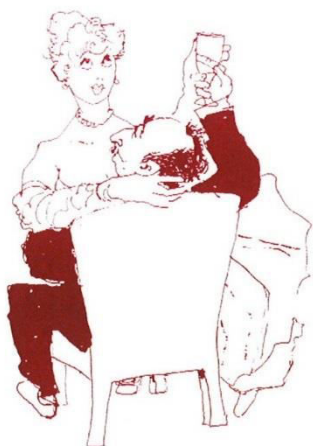
